



1. Adding the App :


- Create a Group by using the Groups Module. Goto Groups - Click Create a Group button and create a group of your choice by filling in the required fields.




- Create a Study Room by enabling the Study Room toggle button




C. The created group will be listed like the below image.




D. Navigate to the Group and click on the Room tab as shown below.




E. Click on the “Create Study Room” button and fill in the required information to create your meeting room.

J. Other users can successfully join this meeting by clicking on the Join button in their PulsedIn account as shown below.




K. Upon joining the meeting successfully, users will be able to discuss and collaborate with their fellow members.




Scopes and Events :

- a. In our application, users can share the meeting to the feed. We would need to show the users about the live status of the meeting. For that, we are using the start meeting and end meeting events.



- b. Using the events, we are showing the status as Live in our application feed. When a meeting starts, we will show that as Live Room in our application, and when the meeting ends, the status will be removed. This can be seen using the above and below images.



View and manage your user information - We are using this scope to get the Zoom user ID and map it for that user for the meeting creation and authentication.

2. Usage: In order to create the study room, you would need to have an account in the [PulsedIn](#) Application.

3. Removing the App :

1. Log in to your Zoom Account and navigate to the Zoom App Marketplace.
2. Click Manage >> Added Apps or search for the "PulsedIn" app.
3. Click the "PulsedIn" app.
4. Click Remove.

The above process will remove the PulsedIn app from the user's Zoom marketplace account. When the user clicks remove, PulsedIn will remove their user ID and tokens from the application.
